

ALMA-ATA INTERNATIONAL LEADERSHIP AWARDS (AILA)

About the program

Alma Ata University (hereafter UAA - Universitas Alma Ata) is a growing and research-oriented university committed to promoting and contributing to human resource development through the development of a high-quality academic culture and research innovation, as well as the strengthening of a global network.

UAA recruits international students to pursue full-time undergraduate and graduate studies in Indonesia who intend to return to their home country. Awardees of the award will attend class activities, community work, and research under the supervision of mentors in all accredited undergraduate and graduate programs of the UAA. Indonesia.

The AILA provides financial support for international students to engage in academic activities in undergraduate and graduate programs at the University of Alma Ata, Indonesia for up to four years for undergraduate programs and two years for graduate programs.

Eligibility

The general requirements to be eligible for the award/scholarship are:

- Must not be citizens of Indonesia.
- For prospective undergraduate students, you are a secondary school or senior high school graduate.
- For prospective master's students, you must hold a bachelor's certificate.
- Obtained excellent results in the study.
- You are not in possession of any other scholarships or grants.
- fluent in English; understanding Bahasa Indonesia is preferred.
- Return to the country of origin after the award is accomplished.

Scholarship Coverage

- Type A Scholarship: Includes full tuition and a living allowance.
- ✓ Type B Scholarship: Includes full tuition and half of the living allowance.
- Type C Scholarship : Full tuition fee
- Type D Scholarship: Living Allowance only
- Economy Round-Trip Flight (1x) (A+, B+, C+).

The type of scholarship received by prospective students is decided by the scholarship committee based on the evaluation of documents and interviews. Tuition fees differ depending on the study program.

The academic performance evaluation will be held every semester. International students need to obtain a GPA of at least 3.00 to keep the scholarship. If the GPA is below 3.00, the following consequences will be applied:

Documents required

- 1. Application form; Please download by filling in the form at **pendaftaran.almaata.ac.id/international-admission**
- 2. Copy of your high school diploma and academic transcript. If the documents are not in English, please provide an official stamp from a trusted translator's office.
- 3. The color scan of the first page of your passport.
- 4. Letter about health or colorblindness
- 5. Current curriculum vitae or resume.
- 6. Motivation letter. The applicant needs to highlight and demonstrate leadership, academic excellence, and innovation.
- 7. Certificate of English proficiency tests (IELTS or TOEFL) taken within the last two years, or a written statement from the applicant saying that English is his or her first language.
- 8. Certificate of Bahasa Indonesia proficiency or Uji Kemahiran Bahasa Indonesia (UKBI) (optional but preferred). You can get more information about UKBI from the Republic of Indonesia's embassy or consulate in your home country.
- 9. Passport-size photos with a red background
- 10. Three reference letters, one must be from a local government or authority such as the mayor or district leader.
- 11. Research outline for Graduate Program Applicant (minimum 3 pages)

General Regulations

- 1. The AAILA is offered for the minimum period that the individual could be expected to complete the academic program. At the level of undergraduate study and graduate study.
- 2. The award includes preparatory programs (Indonesian Language training) 1 semester before the program started.
- 3. Applicants who are accepted into this program will be asked to sign a contract that they will follow the program's rules and follow Indonesian law.
- 4. Conditions may include studying full time and meeting all course requirements. Students may not change enrolment without the prior written approval of the department.
- 5. Awardees are making good academic progress and following the rules about working in the country where they study.
- 6. Awardees accept that the scholarship may be withdrawn by the University board if awardees breach university and country regulations.
- 7. Required to return to their home country on completion of the scholarship.
- 8. Generally, entitlements cover compulsory study fees, an establishment allowance and a living allowance paid monthly. No assistance is available for the airfares of personal and family members.

- Applicants must be supported by local governments or leaders in their home countries, which is indicated by presenting a reference letter from the local leader or local government.
- 10. All applicant's documents will be screened and reviewed by the team of the International Office of Alma Ata University to be selected by the admission committee:
- 11. The selection criteria are merit-based; applicants will be interviewed through an online platform.
- 12. Participants will receive admission results through e-mail (kindly check your e-mail regularly); Please send all the required documents via email at pmb.uaa@almaata.ac.id.
- 13. The selected applicants proceed to the enrollment registration online.
- 14. Awardee of Graduate Program must have 1 publication at least in reputable international database indexed in Scopus or Web of science before graduation.


